Roads Closed Due to Weather Damages in Butler County

Butler, PA— Due to last night's weather activity, the following roads are closed in Butler County.

- State Route 3007 (Three Degree Rd) Adams Township has one lane closed due to trees and wires down.
- State Route 228 Clinton Township both lanes closed due to trees and wires down.
- State Route 8 Slippery Rock Township both lanes closed due to trees and wires down.
- State Route 2018 (Sarver Rd) Buffalo Township both lanes closed due to trees and wires down.

At this time, we do not know when they will be reopened. Motorists should expect delays or use an alternate route.

PennDOT requests that the public follows social distancing guidelines and avoid contact with construction personnel.
